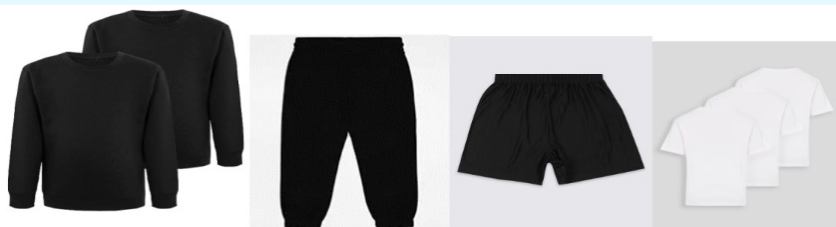
If you wish to sign your child up to lessons, you will have received a letter with information that will highlight the steps to do this, this is directly through Rocksteady.

If you are able to donate a bottle of Calpol to help us replenish our stock, we would be very grateful. This will help us to ensure that we can continue to support the children in school if required.

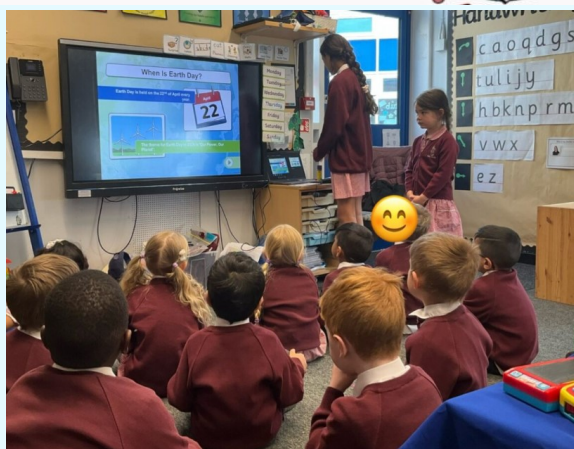
