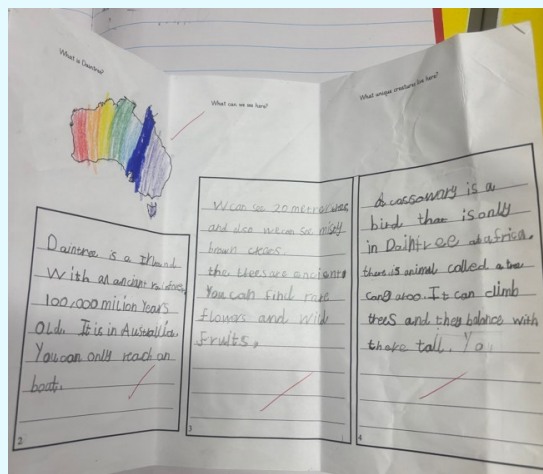
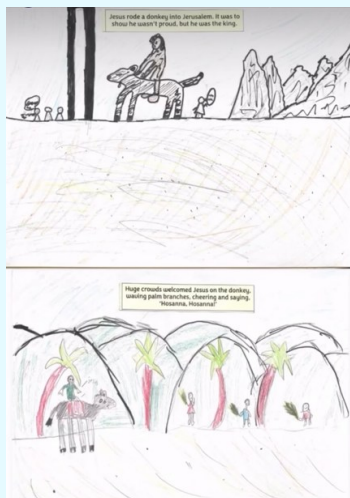
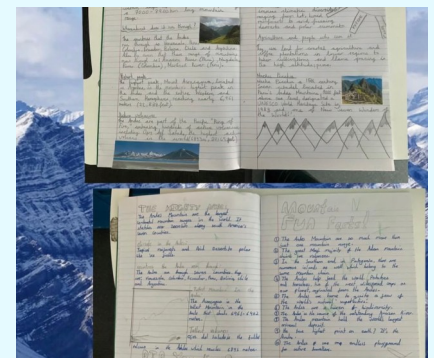
Holy Family News
