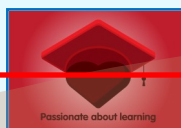
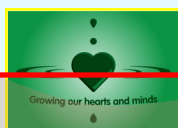
Sports Stars

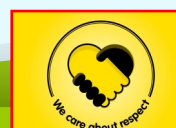
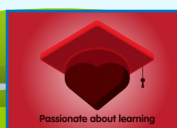
