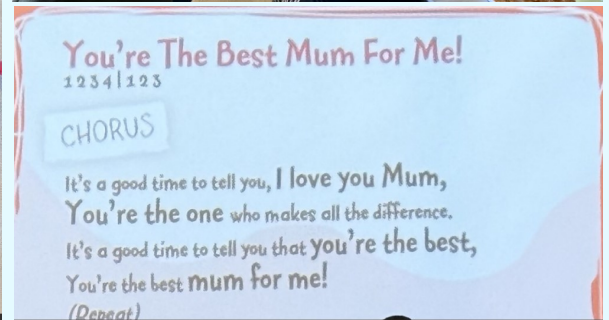
Wheelchair Rugby with Sale Sharks
