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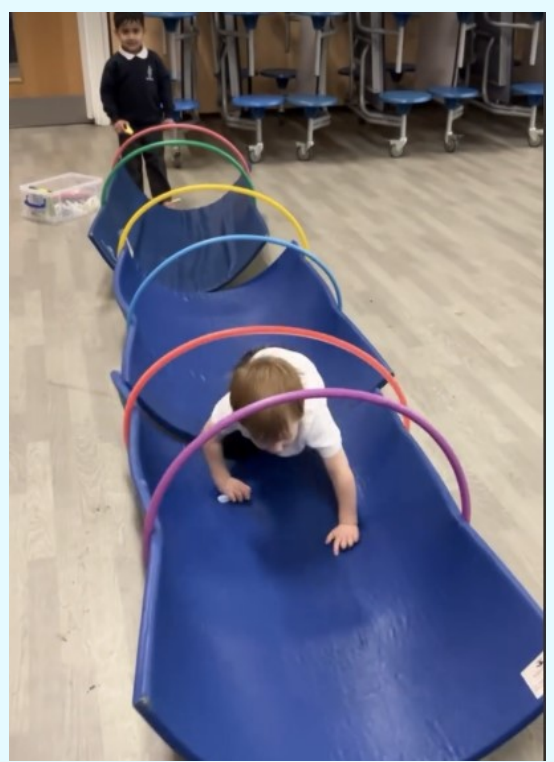
Hello everyone!

Well done Nursery and Thank you to Mrs Bellapianta for a fabulous session!



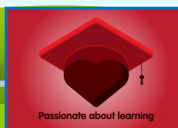
