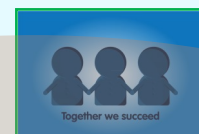
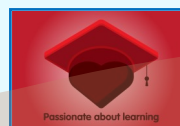
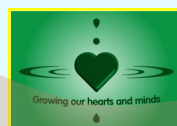


Julie and Hannah cannot run the Friends of Holy Family alone, they really need **YOUR HELP**. This is a plea if you can please spare time to help to organise events by:

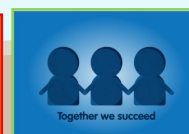
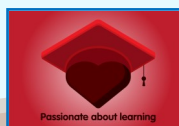
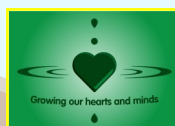
