27th June—cakes and small lucky dip prize





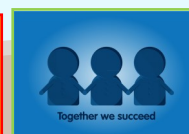
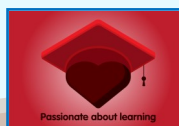
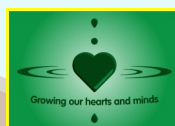
