To prepare for the fair we have some theme days where the children can wear their own clothes:

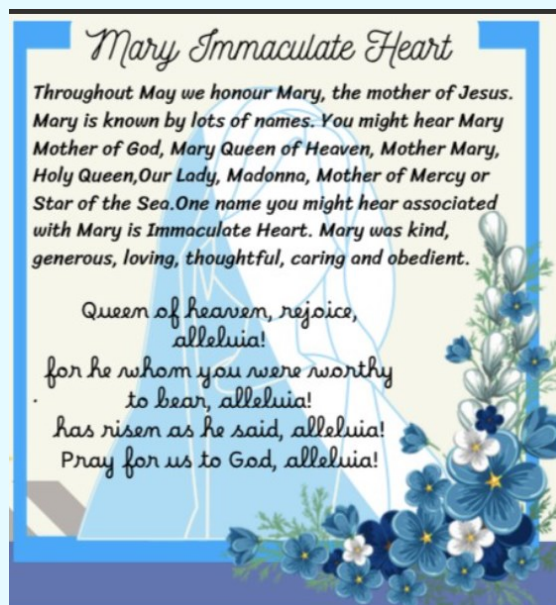
