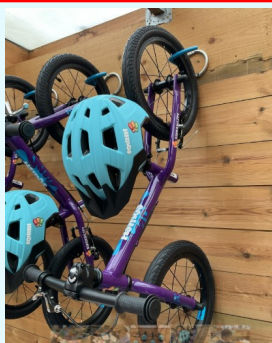


Mrs Talbot left yesterday to start her maternity leave. She was so grateful for all the generous gifts that she was given.

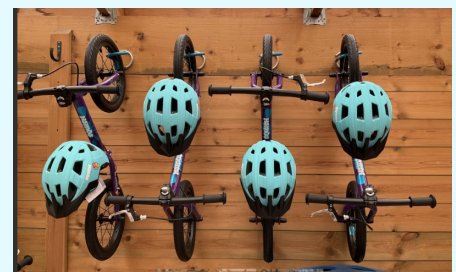
Mrs Hanley will be teaching Year 4 after the Easter break and I am sure she will soon feel part of our team.

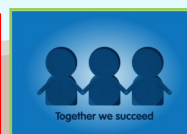
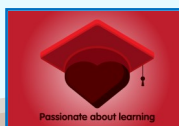
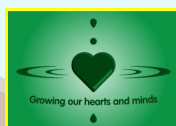
