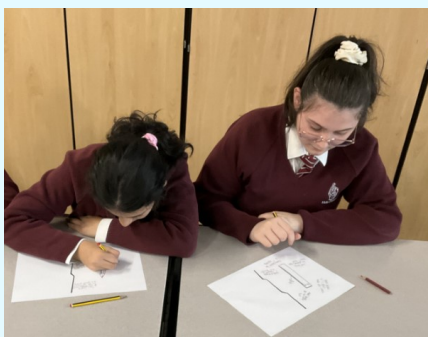
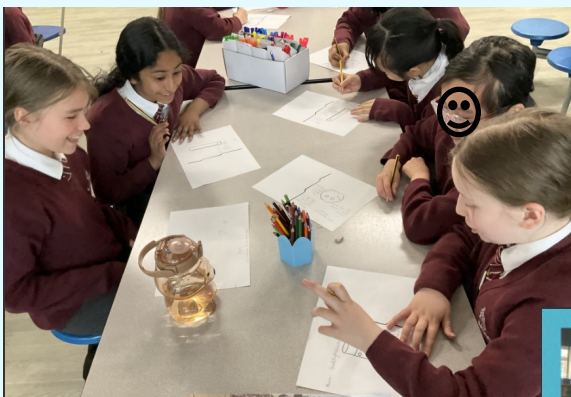

Children should arrive at school at 6pm.

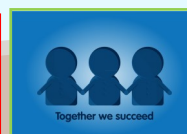
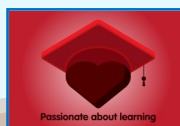
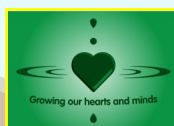
