As a pupil I will:

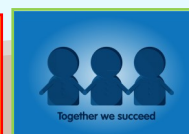
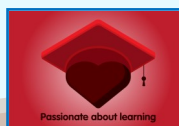
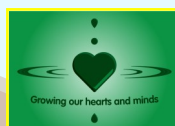
- Come to school every day unless I am too unwell to come.

- Keep parents informed about what is happening in the school via Seesaw and newsletters

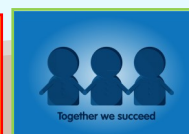
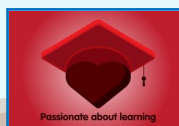
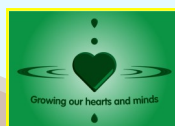


Friends of Holy Family (FOHF)

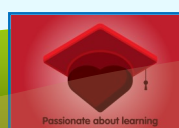
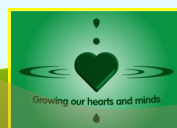
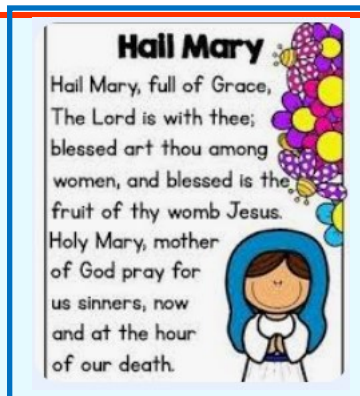
