



Reading Ambassadors

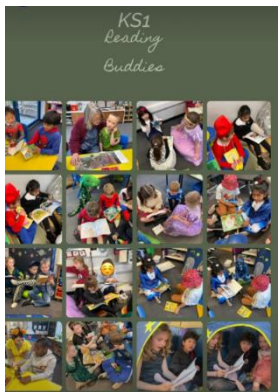
